Dear partners,

We would like to thank you for your prompt replies and your positive approach of getting actively involved in this activity.

The idea of the voluntary activity was to recruit ESC volunteers who will visit local high schools in order to present the project, its objectives, its topics, the produced results from all the previous activities, and discuss with the students upon issues of discrimination, racism and intolerance within their communities having Holocaust as the reference point. However, due to the pandemic, we are obliged to implement this activity virtually.

Therefore, upon receiving the approval of the European Commission to proceed virtually to this activity, and for reasons of eliminating the workload of your side, we propose the following framework for the implementation of this voluntary activity under the abovementioned timeframe and deadlines:

- ✓ The voluntary activity will be implemented to High Schools in Greece virtually under the structure of online workshops.
- ✓ Each partner organisation is **kindly requested** to provide the coordinator with two volunteers for this activity. Thus, each partner should launch a call for 2 volunteers for this activity. After your selection procedures, each organisation should support the volunteers to register themselves to the European Solidarity Corps Database and provide I.R.T.E.A. with their reference number and their contact details.
- ✓ I.R.T.E.A. will be responsible for the implementation of each phase of the activity (as described above) and organise the on-line workshops with the schools.
- ✓ All phases of the activity will be carried out digitally, using zoom platform

In any case, all of you are more than welcome to contribute to this activity, either by supporting the preparation phase, brainstorming on the context and methodology of the activity or in any other desired way.

Enclosed you will find the draft call that that we have developed and a press release for the activity. Please add your logos, the nationality of the volunteers and the contact details of your organisation to the call.

⇒ **Context of workshops / Outline of the Methodology:**

Part A. Presentation of the project and the activities already carried out & Tour to the project's Digital Exhibition about Holocaust.

Part B. Discussion with the students on issues of racism and discrimination within communities. The whole idea is to provide the volunteers of the work already done within the project and encourage them to develop the workshop upon their approach and under the guidance of all of us. Since it will be in a platform like zoom, we will somehow follow the structure of the so-far implemented activities. And since the target group is young people/ students we will add a more non-formal approach to the activity such as ice-breaking games etc.
